

**PLEASE HELP THE OLD-BRULE HERITAGE SOCIETY COMPLETE
THE MEMORIAL WALK AT THE DAVIDSON WINDMILL SITE.**

For the comfort and safety of our guests, the Old-Brule Heritage Society is currently building a sidewalk that joins our new parking area, the Davidson Windmill and the Eskolin Log House. Built into the walkway are dark brick pavers which will carry the names of donors to our cause, or the names of special others as memorials. The pavers are 4 inches wide and 8 inches long, and the design allows for one or two rows of letters along the paver's length. Only fifteen letters maximum from end to end, per row, can be engraved on each paver, including spaces. A \$15 donation will allow us to engrave one paver.

The ConocoPhillips Corporation provided a generous materials grant, but we continue to need help. If you would be interested in joining us in this campaign please send us each of the names you would like to see among the 1000 total pavers. Please print the names exactly as you would like them to appear within the rows of boxes below, after our two examples, "JOHN MAKI 2009" and "JOHN + MARY MAKI".
